On behalf of all those who have been affected by cancer in one way or another, and on behalf of the CHU Dumont Foundation team, thank you from the bottom of our hearts!

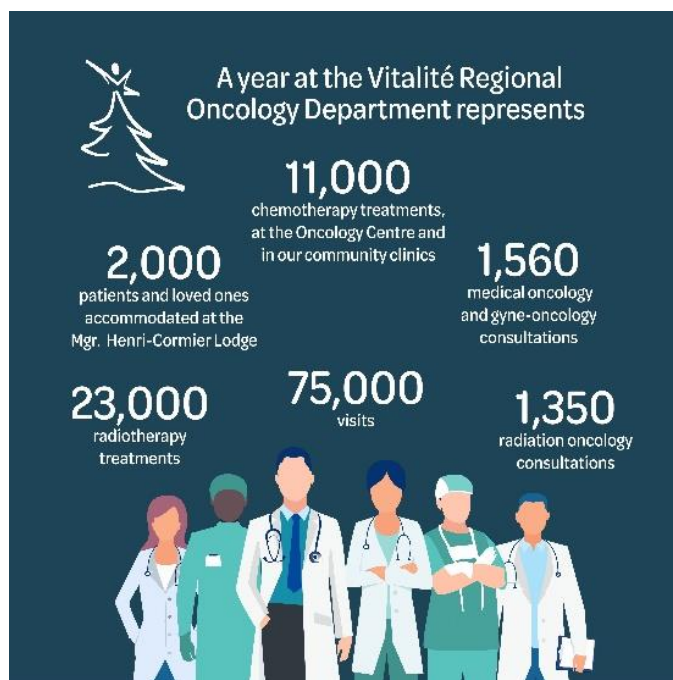
What are the funds raised for?

Since its inception in 1989, the Tree of Hope campaign has raised over \$34 million to help improve the comfort and care of cancer patients at Moncton's Dr. Léon-Richard Oncology Centre and community oncology clinics, not to mention the Mgr. Henri-Cormier Lodge and the research efforts made here. It's all happening right here in New Brunswick!

Funds from the 2023 campaign will be used to equip the Oncology Centre with a specialized stereotactic radiotherapy technique that targets brain tumours caused by cancers other than brain cancer.

"Every year, around a hundred patients come to the Oncology Centre with such diagnoses. Thanks to the generosity of our valued donors, we will be able to treat these patients at home, rather than having to transfer them elsewhere to access the technology."
